Hi everyone,

Some our teams have already passed the one-year anniversary since they relocated from Ray Walsh House while others are about to reach that milestone. It's timely for me to give all staff an update about the remediation project.

## What do I need to know?

You may have noticed that some of the fencing around Ray Walsh House has started to be removed, a sign that Rice Construction Group Pty Ltd has successfully completed the first phase of the remediation project on time and within budget.

They started work about 12 weeks ago, stripping out the interior of the building below ceiling level and as you can appreciate there was a lot of material to remove.

As mentioned in a previous staff update, the Office of Public Works within the Department of Regional NSW were selected by Council to project manage the remediation works, and they have been working closely with Rice Construction Group.

## What is next?

Councillors will attend a workshop at the end of October to discuss the next stage of the project. A report will be presented to a future Council meeting where a decision will be made about the future of the building. A further update will be shared with staff at that time.

## What do I need to do?

Staff do not need to take any specific action – we are letting you know to keep you updated and in case you are approached by any community members. An update to local media will be provided now that staff have been informed.
