### **Incident Update**

The contracted Environmental Hygienist has advised that there is no detection of asbestos fibres on Level 1 or 3. They have also advised that the detection on Level 2 is confined to the fall zone located directly under the ventilation.

### **What now?**

Additional information is being gathered on the required remediation works and associated timelines. Until we have this further information there will continue to be no access to Level 1, 2 and 3 of Ray Walsh. Tomorrow, a team from Risk and Safety, Health and Wellbeing and Building Services and Level 2 staff will start a WHS risk assessment.

Further updates will be provided tomorrow.
